Hunting and fishing IN Traditional Territory



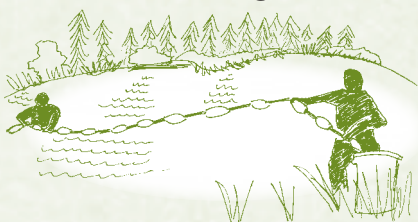
To meet food needs, C/TFN people may hunt and fish on Settlement Land and vacant crown land in C/TFN Traditional Territory any time of the year.

Hunting and fishing OUT OF Traditional Territory

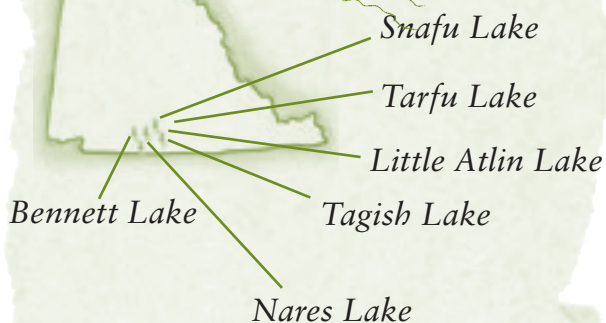


When hunting and fishing in other First Nations traditional territories, C/TFN people must ask for permission from the other First Nation or buy a Yukon hunting or fishing licence.

Fishing



C/TFN fishing needs come first. Yukon must respect the special importance that C/TFN attaches to the lakes in the area.



Total Allowable Harvest



If hunting and fishing have to be limited because of conservation, public health or public safety, then subsistence needs of C/TFN will get priority.



Trapping



C/TFN can make trapping laws on its Settlement Lands.
