JOB SUMMARY

Under the direct supervision of the Director of Health and Wellness, the Auxiliary Outreach Worker provides outreach support and support services to C/TFN citizens in difficult or trying situations involving health issues, child and family matters, justice issues, addictions and/or other social issues. The Auxiliary Outreach Worker will use the Values and Virtues of Life and the Medicine Wheel as the basis of re-engaging and providing opportunities for life skills, education and employment for these C/TFN citizens. The incumbent must be willing to change with the ongoing evolution of C/TFN circle of governance.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Grade 12 graduation and a combination of post-secondary coursework in Social Programs, Counseling, Mental Health, Psychology, Social Sciences, Sociology or equivalent;
- Knowledge of Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder and other mental disorders and ability to help educate others on the topic;
- Experience in assessing and dealing with high risk situations;
- Knowledge of C/TFN Family Act, Book 1 & 2;
- Knowledge or willingness to implement any accepted concepts into the program; good knowledge of the communities of Carcross, Tagish, Squanga and Whitehorse;

CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT

- C/TFN Health & Wellness Department encourages all department employees to be role models and working on their individual wellness plan;
- Must submit to a Criminal Record Check;
- Willingness to work flexible hours
- May occasionally be required to transport clients on an as needed basis;
- Function in a potentially stressful environment;
- May interact with individuals with substantially different values, beliefs, experiences, and training;
- It is each employee's responsibility to obtain liability insurance (business) on them
- own vehicle; and provide receipt to employer for reimbursement.
