#### JOB SUMMARY

Reporting to the Chief Financial Officer (or designate), the IT Manager will provide strategic guidance to C/TFN with regards to technology and IT infrastructure and enable major business processes through enhancements to IT and resolution of issues.

The IT Manager assumes leadership, responsibility, control and influence over the IT team ensuring that the team's work meets the specifications of the business requirements, technical performance, the selection and procurement, user training and feedback, and the schedule, as outlined in the department's goals and objectives.

### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Analyze, design, develop, integrate and implement information systems business solutions, and provide advice on information systems strategy, policy, management, security and service delivery
- Operate, administer and maintain computer and telecommunications software, networks and information systems
- Experience supporting the delivery and implementation of complex projects, including projects where regular operations must be maintained throughout project implementation
- Experience building and maintaining effective and collaborative working relationships with stakeholders and partners
- Review diagnostics and assess the functionality, efficiency of systems and install and update company software and hardware and training for users
- Develop and update client documentation and internal procedures for incident management, maintenance and resolution
- Offer technical support to C/TFN employees, troubleshoot computer problems and provide timely resolution of service incidents.

- Monitor security certificates and company compliance of requirements and implement security measures
- Collaborate with vendors, contractors and suppliers to perform research and gather information about evolving products/technologies; discuss technical issues; investigate product specific problems; determine product compatibility and availability
