Under the direction of the of the Haa Yatx'i Hidi Manager, the Haa Yatx'i Hidi Cook is responsible for the daily operation of the Haa Yatx'i Hidi Kitchen. This position is responsible for ensuring that the centre operates effectively in meeting the needs of the children in the provision of hot meals and snacks for infants, toddlers, pre-school and school aged children.
