JOB SUMMARY

Under the direct supervision of the Director of Heritage Lands & Natural Resources (HLNR), the Lands Manager is responsible for developing, implementing and administering land management programs for the Carcross/Tagish First Nation (C/TFN) and for integrating the four elements of the Values and Virtues of Life (mental, emotional, spiritual and physical) into these programs. The Lands Manager will also ensure the programs reflect, where possible, life's four stages - child, youth, adult and elder. The Lands Manager must be willing to change with the ongoing evolution of C/TFN circle governance.

QUALIFICATIONS

- A Diploma in Renewable Resources, Land Management, Natural Resource Management or related discipline;
- Knowledge of and experience in land administration systems
- Knowledge of C/TFN traditional territory;
- Knowledge of land related impacts and pressures;
- A combination of work experience and education as well as scientific and traditional knowledge.

CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT

- Must undertake a Criminal Records Check
- Valid Yukon Class 5 drivers license
- Located mainly in an office environment with field work, as often required, in the C/TFN traditional territory
- May experience stress when meeting deadlines and handling heavy workloads
- Dealing with constant interruptions and high levels of regular/irregular critical deadlines
- May experience eye strain, wrist strain, back pain from working with computers
- To function in a potentially stressful environment
- May include working extended work hours and or weekends
- Responsible for getting self to and from work on time
