JOB SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Haa Yátx'i Hidí Manager, the Haa Yátx'i Hidí Cook is responsible for the daily operation of the Haa Yátx'i Hidí kitchen. This position is responsible for ensuring that the centre operates effectively in meeting the needs of the children in the provision of hot meals and snacks for infants, toddlers, pre-school and school aged children.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Creating and implementing a nutrition program;
- Preparing healthy meals and snacks for groups of 25;
- Plan menus based on the Canadian Nutritional Guidelines;
- Daily deep cleaning and sanitizing kitchen;
- Order groceries based on meal plans; and
- Support the operational needs of Haa Yátx'i Hidí.

DESIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & SUITABILITY

- Grade 12 or GED;
- Completion of Early Childhood Educator Level 1; (or willingness to obtain within the first 6 months)
- Sound knowledge of First Nations culture and traditions;
- Basic computer skills for online ordering, preparing menu plans, correspondence with stakeholders;
- Good interpersonal skills, caring attitude, ability to relate to children and must have a high stress tolerance;
- Ability to work in a cross-cultural environment;
- Ability to maintain confidentiality;
- Ability to work with minimum supervision;
- Ability to work effectively and efficiently, both independently or as a team member;
- Strong decision-making skills, including good judgement;

- Strong time management, organizational and prioritization skills; and
- Good communication skills- oral, listening, written and electronic.
