JOB SUMMARY

Under the direct supervision of Heritage, Lands and Natural Resources Department Field Operations Manager, the Ecological Environmental Land Monitor is responsible for overseeing and meeting technical requirements associated with C/TFN natural resources and heritage. The Ecological Environmental Land Monitor will ensure that their responsibilities reflect life's four stages – child, youth, adult and elder, and be willing to change with the ongoing evolution of C/TFN circle of governance.

This position is open to C/TFN Citizens only.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Ecological/Environmental Land monitor performs functions for CTFN by:

- Following a weekly work schedule as identified by the Field Operations Manager and responsibly and timely implementing tasks presented therein.
- Environmental assessment reviews, proposals and consultations.
- Assists in administering case files.
- Environmental compliance monitoring.
- GPS tracking and data upload.
- Assists with assessments on economic development projects for environmental/ecological effects.
- Conducts site inspections.

- Participates in daily briefings with the Natural Resources Manager or her/his designee to review the work plan and goals for the day.
- Immediately communicates schedule changes to the Natural Resources Manager and/or department Administrative Officer.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Diploma in Renewable Resources or equivalent. Candidates with related credentials and experience may be considered.
- Knowledge of C/TFN history, culture, demographics, goals and aspirations is an asset.
- Personal suitability for the job is essential
- Conflict resolution skills are an asset
- Experience in the field is an asset, as is a willingness to travel in all weather conditions for extended periods of time
