Responsibilities will include instruction and guide services for activities such as bike tours, walking tours, horse tours and on the water paddling. While leading a tour, Guides will manage all aspects of the tour, and are responsible for interpretive information, risk management, and guest satisfaction.

The Lead Outdoor Interpretive Guide will provide basic maintenance for all related equipment facilities and trails. The work location will primarily be within a 20 km radius of the learning

Centre location in Carcross, Guides will assist with administrative duties and sales and

bookings. The Lead Outdoor Interpretative Guide will be responsible for training and assisting Junior Interpretative Guides.
