Carcross/Tagish First Nation is announcing an election for Haa Shaa du Hen on May 15th 2020.

CARCROSS – Carcross/Tagish First Nation is now ready to officially enter into the election process with all dates confirmed. The appointed Chief Electoral Officer (CEO), Tanya Silverfox, will be assisting with the election process until the end of May 2020.

Today the writ has been issued and the call for nominations is now open. As per the C/TFN election code, any Citizens that wishes to run for Haa Shaa du Hen (Chief) has until March 31st to bring their name forward. This C/TFN election is a regular election for one Haa Shaa du Hen (1 Chief) that will sit in office for a period of 4 years.
