






#### **ORANGE TABLE OPTIONS:**


- On the left at lake side suggest this table for MC podium, and a table for signing marriage certificates
- On the right at lake side suggest this area for slideshow presentations
- At the highway side of hall suggest for AV / Musician
- In middle of room -suggest this for guest sign in
- Catering to have separate table for drinks and food pick up

## HAA SHAGÓON HÍDI - WEDDINGS







**Theatre Style** seating is best suited for groups delivering a presentation or forum.




**Conference Style** is best suited for meetings such as board of directors meetings that require groups less than 30 seated together and decisions to be made. Any group larger than this would have difficulty hearing one another.




**Classroom Style** seating is best suited for groups wanting a presentation but for participants to have a desk to take notes on their observations.



**Round Tables** for Banquet Seating allows for up to 8 seats per table and can be staggered in the above manner to maximize seating capacities.



**Classic Banquet** seating allows the most people in the room for a seating style with tables. A head table for 24 people can be placed at the top of room with three long rows can run the length of our Main Hall.



**U Shaped** seating is best for presentations that require interactions. When no chairs are inside the U this also works well for presentations or films or dinner.
