Under the direct supervision of the Senior Manager, the Trapper Coordinator is responsible for developing, implementing and administering Trapping Programs for the Carcross/Tagish First Nation (C/TFN), and for integrating the four elements of the Values and Virtues of Life (mental, emotional, spiritual and physical) into these programs. The Trapper Coordinator must be willing to change with the ongoing evolution of C/TFN circle governance.
